Green Maps use the visual language of the Green Map icon system to share information about local resources such as: recycling points, local businesses, community gardens, green energy sites, biodiversity spots, bike routes and social enterprises. Green Map icons can also identify challenges such as: pollution, gentrification and habitat loss.

Highlighting issues on a map, using the Green Map icons, helps people to communicate what they value and what they want to change, simply and effectively.

Green Map icons are matched to the **UN Sustainable Development Goals,** supporting people to translate local issues into a global framework.

- Import several data formats, including GPX (cycle and walking routes), sound, images and text.
- Export data for analysis in multiple formats.
